RESOLUTION 2025 - 23

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO EMPLOY SPECIAL COUNSEL TO ASSIST IN PROSECUTION OF CERTAIN CASES

WHEREAS, the Lewis and Clark County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance in the prosecution of *State v. Melody Lynn Foster* and *State v. Jack Gonzales Foster*, pending in the Montana First Judicial District Court, Lewis and Clark County; and

WHEREAS, it is desired and deemed appropriate that a special deputy county attorney(s) be appointed to assist in the prosecution of the aforementioned case; and

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. § 44-4-111 authorizes and contemplates the training coordinator for county attorneys and the bureau chief of Prosecution Services Bureau (together with the deputies of said bureau) act as special counsel on request of the county attorney and upon the approval of the board of county commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-501(6) authorizes the Attorney General to provide assistance to county attorneys in the discharge of their duties,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the attorneys assigned to the Prosecution Services Bureau of the Department of Justice are hereby appointed as special deputy county attorneys for Lewis and Clark County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned cases and that any of said deputies can fulfill the functions set out in Mont. Code Ann. § 44-4-103.
- 2. That under the terms of this agreement, no fee will be charged for attorney time provided by the Bureau. Assistance in such cases is provided without an hourly fee. Witness fees and expenses, jury costs, and other normal costs associated with trial will be the County's responsibility as with all other prosecutions.

Before you today is a request to adopt Contract Amendment No. 2 with JHS, Inc. for the Craig-Wolf Creek Mosquito District. This contract was initially put in place May 4th, 2023, and is a three-year professional services contract between Lewis and Clark County and JHS, Inc. Changes within this amendment include:

- The dates within section (6) <u>Effective Date and Time of Performance</u> of the contract were updated to match this year's schedule.
- Under section (7) <u>Compensation</u> the compensation amount is not to exceed Sixteen Thousand and Eight Hundred Dollars (\$16,800.00). Upon receipt of invoices and deliverables applicable identified in section J of Scope of Servies compensation will be made to JHS in the following manner:
 - On or before June 15, 2025, 45% or \$7,560.00
 - On or before August 15, 2025, 45% or \$7,560.00
 - On or before December 1, 2025, 10% or \$1,680.00

LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 2

This Amendment is made to the Contract dated May 4, 2023, made between Lewis and Clark County, herein referred to as "COUNTY", and JHS Inc., herein referred to as "CONSULTANT", whose address is PO Box 4667, Helena, Montana 59604, phone number is (406)443-7487, and Federal Employee Identification Number is 81-0454811.

The portions of the agreement affected by this amendment are listed below and replaced in their entirety:

6. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TIME OF PERFORMANCE: JHS Inc. shall commence work approval of this contract by both parties and season work 2025 work must be completed by December 31, 2025. This contract amendment is the last of the three-year contact period.

7. - On or before August 15, 2025, 45% or \$7,560.00
- On or before December 1, 2025, 10% or \$1,680.00

COUNTY and CONSULTANT hereby agree to modify the above-referenced contract sections as set forth in this amendment. All provisions of the Contract not modified by this or previous amendments remain in full effect.


